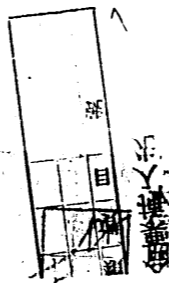

Declaration of a State of War

Between the United States
of America

and the Imperial German
Government

Sixty-fifth Congress of the United States of America;

At the First Session,

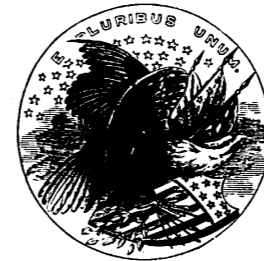
Began and held at the City of Washington on Monday, the second day of April,
one thousand nine hundred and seventeen.

JOINT RESOLUTION

Declaring that a state of war exists between the Imperial German Government
and the Government and the people of the United States and making
provision to prosecute the same.

Whereas the Imperial German Government has committed repeated acts of
war against the Government and the people of the United States of
America: Therefore be it

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States
of America in Congress assembled, That the state of war between the United
States and the Imperial German Government which has thus been thrust upon
the United States is hereby formally declared; and that the President be, and
he is hereby, authorized and directed to employ the entire naval and military
forces of the United States and the resources of the Government to carry on war
against the Imperial German Government; and to bring the conflict to a
successful termination all of the resources of the country are hereby pledged by
the Congress of the United States.

FOR RESOLUTION 373 - AGAINST RESOLUTION 50 - NOT VOTING 9

The Sixty-fifth Congress, the War Congress, met at noon April 2, 1917, pursuant to a proclamation of the President of the United States. The Hon. Thomas R. Marshall, Vice President, presided over the Senate, and the Hon. Champ Clark, from Missouri, presided over the House of Representatives. The resolution declaring a state of war to exist between the United States and the Imperial German Government, was introduced by Senator Martin, of Virginia, was passed by the Senate April 4, 1917, by the House of Representatives on April 5, 1917, and approved by President Wilson April 6, 1917.
