



I have the honor to inclose herewith the original of self explanatory letter received at this service from Nippon Yusen Kaisha regarding the request of the South Sea Is. Government at Palau to make direct dispatch of mail matters from Davao to those islands.

In view that that this matter treats an International relations between Japanese Government and our Government, I have the honor to request that I be informed as early as possible if the request may be granted in order that no considerable delay of mails from Davao to the places referred above.

At present we receive constantly direct mail dispatches from the Japanese Mandate Islands, Government at Palau thru foreign steamers that call at this port. In looking over our records I can not find any authority from that office of making direct dispatch from this office.

Acknowledging the receipt of your letter of the 3rd January last, concerning the making up of direct closed mails from Davao to Palau, I have the honor of inform you that this Administration has no objection to the despatch of the closed mails above referred to and that, as to the parcel mails, a charge calculated at the rate of 40 centimes (gold) per parcel, regardless of the weight of parcels, should be payable to this Administration as a compensation of the sea service.

Re: Your despatch of mail matters to

Japanese Mandate Island in South
Sea.

Recently, we are requested by the Sou Sea Is. Government at Palau that all the mail matters addressed to Japanese Mandate Island Scattered in that region be kindly arranged by your authorities to always send direct by N.Y.K. South Sea Is. Liners, instead of forwarding around by way of Manila and Japan ports in the North as the latter will take considerably longer time to reach at destination in the South Sea. At Present, S.S."Yokohamamaru" and S.S."Omi Maru" are placed in service on this line and calling at Davao regularly once a month. hence we will keep you well informed of their Sailings from Davao well before-hand in future, should you be able to kindly meet the requirement of our government at Palau. kindly confirm at your earliest convenience.
