2. Upon receipt of above request every step has been taken to locate the subject person, and by a letter of his wife which answered to a radio query it became clear that FUJINAGA Genshi died in 1946 and his wife FUJINAGA Yumi is domiciled at No. 1462, Akada-machi, Shimonoseki-shi, Yamaguchi-ken.

3. Thereupon the following queries were made to FUJINAGA Yumi from this Office:

a. Did Mr. FUJINAGA Genshi receive any renumeration from "Fujiya Hotel" in Bombay during both fiscal years 1941 to 1942 and 1942 to 1943?

b. If he did, how much (to report by each fiscal year)?

c. How was Fujiya Hotel found at the time of repatriation of FUJINAGA Genshi?

4. The answer made by his wife to these queries is as follows:

a. Though detailed information is not obtainable because of the death of FUJINAGA Genshi, it is presumed that he did not receive any renumeration from Fujiya Hotel in Bombay during the period 1941 to 1943. He came back to Japan in November 1940 for medical treatment, leaving the hotel management to the hands of his brother-in-law TOMIZAWA Hiroshi, manager of the hotel.

b. As it was during the war time when he restored in health he was unable to visit Bombay again. And after the outbreak of the war, TOMIZAWA Hiroshi was repatriated to Japan aboard the last exchange ship, abandoning the hotel in operation at that time.
