3. Regarding the nature of the position held by the subject individual, the ministry reports as follows:

The post of a chancellor-interpreter of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to which Sekifumi ISHIKAWA was appointed on 28 July 1943, as stated in his personal history, is an official one in the Japanese Government. There is no express provision in any Japanese law specially stipulating the possession of Japanese nationality for the appointment as a Japanese Government official.

It is, however, prescribed in the Nationality Law, Article 24, Paragraph 2, that a person who actually holds an official post, civil or military, will not lose Japanese nationality notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding eight articles until after he or she has lost such official post, and the Pension Law, which provides for pension to retired government and public officials, mentions in Article 9 the loss of Japanese nationality as a cause for the loss of the right of pension. In the light of these provisions it is clear that the possession of Japanese nationality is an indispensable prerequisite to the appointment as a Japanese Government official so far as the Japanese national laws are concerned. As a matter of practice, appointments in the various Japanese Government agencies have been made in the past along the said line.

The possession of Japanese nationality may, therefore, be said to be indispensable for the appointment to the post of a chancellor-interpreter in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

- a. Tadayuki NISHIKAWA is considered to have served in the Japanese Army on the basis of the records kept at the said Bureau.
- b. According to the above records, he was called into the Field Motor Depot, 14th Regional Army in the Philippines on 15 December 1944. His fate became unknown for some time since 10 June 1945, but was found alive by the subsequent investigation. At the time when he was missing, he still belonged to the said Depot and his rank was 1st Class Private.
- c. The fact that he was called up in 1938 and again in 1940, but each time was discharged from the call and ordered to return home on the same date, is not confirmed on the basis of the records kept at the said Bureau, the Prefectural Assistance Section, and the City Office of his permanent domicile.
- d. It is presumed that the fact that he was called into the Japanese Army in the Philippines in 1944 was informed neither to the Prefectural Assistance Section (formerly Regimental District Headquarters) of his permanent domicile nor to the City Office of his permanent domicile due to communication difficulties in those days.

3. The Second Demobilization Bureau Liquidation Division reports that no official record concerning his service in the Japanese Navy has been found, despite investigations made by the said Division and by every District Demobilization Liquidation Division.
