In accordance with SCAP memorandum under reference 1b. a way has been opened for direct communications between the Japanese Government and Japanese nationals or former Japanese nationals residing in foreign countries in regard to the matters of their nationality and personal status. In this connection, it is requested that good offices of the General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, be used in order that the following information may be made known to Japanese residents in countries other than those where there exist the Representatives of Japanese Interests, especially the continental U.S., Canada, Cuba, Colombia, Venezuela, and Argentina.

According to a newspaper report (The Jiji Shimbun, 6 June 1949), the government of Thailand seems to have recently given official recognition to the right of residence of some 1,000 Japanese who still remain in that country. If that is actually the case, the Japanese residents in that country will be duly entitled, under SCAP memorandum referenced in 1b, to direct communications with Japanese Government concerning matters of their nationality and personal status. It is hoped, therefore, that the General Headquarters be good enough to make inquiries into the authenticity of the news and, if it is true, to take necessary steps to inform the Japanese residents there of the following.

a. The Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs, having been authorized by the General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, will henceforth receive all notification and other papers under the Nationality and the Personal Status Law, and all papers of legal procedure of Japanese residents in foreign countries. The Japanese residents abroad are requested to mail to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Tokyo, all such papers, including those overdue from past years, addressed to the head of city, ward, town or village, or any other central or local Japanese Government organ con-

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs will forward these notifications and papers to their respective destinations. In case they are found irregular or incorrect in contents or form, the senders will be so notified. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs will answer by mail all inquiries relating to nationality and personal status.

b. Under the new Constitution of Japan, the provisions relating to the matters of relatives and succession in the Civil Code, and Family Registration Law have been drastically revised as from January 1, 1948. The Nationality Law has also been partly amended.

Japanese residents abroad must conform to these new laws. Explanatory pamphlets of the forms of notification and registration under the new laws are being forwarded to Representative of Japanese Interests as well as to Japanese associations and individuals abroad.

- c. Persons who have obtained certificates of registration from the authorities concerned of the country where they reside are directed to send copies of the same together with notification properly made out under the new law.
- d. There might have been quite a number of such notifications, as had been sent from the Americas, between April 1941 and the war's end, and had never reached the family register offices in Japan because of the hazards of transmission in those days. Some notifications, which were entrusted to returning Japanese officials, might have been lost or destroyed in the disasters attending the war. Accordingly, a person who submitted notifications during the period between March 1, 1941, and August 31, 1945, is advised to re-submit notifications, stating in addition the date of his original notification and, in the case of a person coming under 3 above, attaching copies of certificates concerned. Notifications of Japanese residents in Argentina are all safely preserved in that country, and no re-submission is required.
- c. No re-submission is required, as to the birth or death the notification of which was already submitted to Representatives of Japanese Interests after the war's end.

- a. Inclosed herewith is the military history, with its English translation, of KANEDA, Kei referred to as KANEDA, Key in reference Check Sheet.
- b. According to the records in the custody of the said Division he entered the Miho Kaigun Koku Tai (Miho Naval Flying Corps) as one of the 15th time Koshu Hiko Yoka Renshusel ("A" Class Flight Preliminary Trainees) and the war was over while he was in the above training course. On 1 September 1945 when demobilized. he was especially given the rank of Naval Flight Petty Officer, 2nd Class.
- 3. To the questions given in para. 4 of reference Check Sheet the said Division replies as follows:
 - a. KANEDA, Kei is not considered to have been actually in the service of the Navy at any time during the period from 15 September 1944 to 1 September 1945, as he was still a flight preliminary trainee when he was demobilized.
 - b. He naturally ought to have been subject to the Naval laws and regulations relating to the service, discipline and others at any time during that period, as he was enlisted into the Navy as a flight preliminary trainee.
 - c. His rank as Naval Flight Petty Officer, 2nd Class was legitimate in accordance with a usual naval practice. However, the said rank was conferred on him honorarily at the time of his demobilization and therefore, he has neither been given the treatment, nor has been in the service of the Navy corresponding to his rank.

ANDIECT: Request for Separation of Yasuharu Aoki's Private Funds from Public Funds Account of Former Japanese Embassy, Ankara, Held in Switzerland.

1. In a petition addressed to the Minister for Foreign Affairs, a opy of which in English translation is enclosed herewith, Mr. Yasuharu oki, who was a steff member of the former Japanese Embassy at Ankara, states that his private deposits with La Societe de Banque Suisse, Geneva, witzerland, totaling 25,950 Swiss francs, were transferred to the public funds account of the former Japanese Embassy, Ankara, at the same bank on three occasions from the latter part of 1944 to the beginning of 1945 (these public funds, together with Mr. Aoki's deposits, being subsequently transferred to the public funds account of the former Japanese Legation at Berne at the Banque Nationale Suisse of the same city). He further states that, later on, he requested the bank to restore his private funds, but that, under the circumstances then prevailing, the bank was unable to comply with the request, his private funds being left included in the said public funds account to this date. Accordingly, he asks for the separation of his private funds from the public funds account.

2. The sum of 25,950 Swiss francs mentioned by Mr. Yasuharu Aoki belongs to him as a private individual, and has no connection whatever with public funds, as is testified by former Ambassador Sho Kurihara, who was Chief of the Japanese Embassy, Ankara, at the time concerned. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs would be grateful if the General Headquarters would be so kind as to use its good offices with the Swiss and other authorities concerned, so that Mr. Aoki's private funds may be separated from the public funds account mentioned above, with a view to their restitution to him.
