2. The Japanese Government agencies concerned, being desirous of furthering the principle of liberal shipping, have in concert been exploring all possibilities of revising the existing procedural requirements, as stated in paragraph 6 of the reference letter, and have agreed upon the following conclusion, which is supplementary to the contents of the reference letter.

- a. It should be clarified here again that the current legislation providing that the Government licence shall be required in certain cases for a shipping contract to carry import or export goods has been enacted, as pointed out in the reference letter, solely to meet the requirements of foreign exchange control, but with no intention whatever of discriminatory treatment according to the flag of the ships. It is the sincere intention of the Japanese Government to cooperate in the realization of a liberal shipping policy, by removing as much as possible restrictions upon shipping activities engaged in international trade. It hopes on the other hand that the other countries will accord equal and non-discriminatory treatment to Japanese ships.
- b. With such hope the Japanese Government wishes to express its willingness to revise the existing procedural requirement for the shipping activities of a country who will accord equal and non-discriminatory treatment to the shipping of Japanese vessels, in accordance with the general principle of reciprocity.

Ministry that on 8 September 1951 Mr. Kiyoshi Iida, local operator
of a spinnery whose address is: 1629, Tateno, Itori-mura, Iwata-gun,
Shizuoka Prefecture, found two diamond rings wrapped in a red-color
handkerchief in one of the old stockings imported from the United States
which he had bought for reproduction purposes from a wholesaler of im-
ported old wear, Mr. Takao Takemoto of Akumi-machi, Toyohashi-shi, Aichi
Prefecture in the beginning of July 1951 and that Mr. Iida has imme-
diately turned them over into the protective custody of the Iwata area
police station, wishing that the jewels be returned to the proper owner,
believedly residing in the United States, through the good offices of
the Japanese Government.

Detailed information is: both rings are platinum, each mounted
with seven small diamonds, the weight of the one being 3.8 grammes
(valued at 100,000 yen) and the other 3.2 grammes (valued at 50,000
yen); the size of the wrapping handkerchief is 900 square centimeters.

stray jewels may be safely returned to the rightful owner as soon as

1. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs has received a petition as per Enclosure 1 from Wada, Mitsu, a returnee from Korea, for the repatriation of her third son, WADA, Masao, who has been left in Korea. The facts as ascertained as result of inquiry are as follows:

On 15 December 1950, WADA, Mitsu lost sight of her third son while she was taking refuge from Seoul to Pusan with her four children. She tried in vain to find him out, and in the circumstances had to file an application, under the date of 10 January 1951, for the repatriation of herself and the three other children. After she obtained the permission of the General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, however, the whereabouts of the third son could be located. She wanted to take steps for his repatriation as well, but time did not allow it. If she should persist to take him along, the other members of the family might have to miss the forthcoming opportunity of return. So she departed from Pusan on 27 August 1951, leaving the third son alone in Korea.

2. The statement in her petition may be given credence in every respect, and it is only natural that she should desire her reunion with the third son. The Ministry would, therefore, be grateful if the General Headquarters would give favorable consideration to the matter so that her earnest wish could be granted. (Particulars about the mother and son are shown in Enclosure 2.)

In case WADA, Masao's entry into Japan is permissible, the General Headquarters is requested to be so good as to inform the Ministry of it, and also to notify the prospective repatriate, whose photograph is attached to the translated petition, through the Government of the Republic of Korea.
