To His Excellency

Lieut. General Oyama Iwano,

His Imperial Japanese Majesty's

Minister of War.

Sir,

I have the honor to send herewith
and commend to your favorable
consideration an improved, worn
Cartridge belt, which has been approved
by the government of the United States
and is now in general use in the Army
of that country. This belt is intended
to supersede all other forms of belt and
cartridge box for military use and has
proved superior in all respects to

any other device for the purpose.
This letter, and some sample belts for
your examination, will be handed you
by General Saigō Tsukunichi, who has
inspected them and who has kindly
consented to bring them to your notice.
At such time as you may find cause
convenient I shall be glad to call upon
you and explain fully the belt and its
use and also the terms upon which it
may be secured for use in His Majesty's
Army should it meet with the approval
of your department. Please send your reply
care of His Excellency Mr Bingham,
Minister of the United States, U.S. Legation.
Hoping for an early reply and with much
